About the Facility:

Westminster College is a small, liberal arts college located in a vibrant Salt Lake City neighborhood. The College has built a new Science Center to accommodate the current and future technologies and meet the ever changing needs of the school.

The 60,000 square foot facility includes state of the art laboratory and classroom environments for each of the scientific disciplines (Physics, Geology, Biology, Ecology, and Chemistry). Also included in the facility are informal lounges where students can gather for project collaboration, faculty offices, and a large atrium space for student congregation and interaction.

With the realization that learning happens everywhere in the facility, the design of the new building provides informal gathering spaces that can be utilized for student gatherings outside of the classroom experience. These spaces are meant to enhance student collaboration, and to provide a variety of settings for learning.

The Science Center is a model of sustainable building principles and practices, and a learning tool to exhibit those principles to its students and faculty, making the building a demonstration of the College's commitment to environmental stewardship.
